ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY THEATRE

The purposes for which the corporation is organized Article 5. PURPOSES. are: The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, including but not limited to the following: (1) To foster and encourage the development of, and commitment to, the highest standards by community theatres throughout the United States of America, including standards of excellence for production, management, governance and community relations and service; (2) to receive from interested persons and organizations, hold, manage and disburse funds to carry out the foregoing purposes; (3) to make available services, publications, programs, meetings and other activities designed (a) to meet the needs of non-profit community

theatres and those actively engaged in or supporting their activities and (b) to further the purposes set forth in clause (l) of this Article 5; (4) to provide leadership for growth in excellence in all aspects of community theatre activity; (5) to establish and maintain working relationships with persons and organizations in other theatre fields; (6) to provide a national voice for community theatre and to join with and support other organizations devoted to making known the human, social, cultural and economic values of living theatre and other art forms and the arts generally.

Provided, however, that (a) no substantial part of the properties or income of the corporation shall ever be used or employed directly or indirectly by the corporation for the purpose of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; and (b) no part of the properties or income of the corporation shall be used or employed directly or indirectly by the corporation for the purpose of participating in or intervening in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The corporation has such powers as are now and may hereafter be granted by the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of the State of Illinois.

- Article 6. QUORUM OF DIRECTORS. Unless otherwise provided in the bylaws, a quorum shall consist of one-third of the whole Board of Directors.
- Article 7. DISSOLUTION. Upon the dissolution of this corporation all of its assets remaining after making provision for its liabilities shall be transferred and assigned to such other organization or organizations classified as a Section 501 (c)(3) organization by the Internal Revenue Service of the United States of America, as may be selected by the Board of Directors of the corporation.
